The Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation and Stafford County invite you to join in on a Spring Field Day at Crow's Nest Natural Area Preserve - one of the more remarkable gems within the Virginia Natural Area Preserve System. This field day is one of several being held in 2011 to honor and promote awareness of Virginia's most significant natural places and to celebrate the Natural Heritage Program's 25th Anniversary. The state preserve system protects some of the best examples of natural communities and habitat for the rarest plants and animals in Virginia. There are now 60 dedicated Natural Area Preserves totaling 50,492 acres protecting 378 unique, significant natural communities and rare plant and animal species.
